- A Michigan Appeals Court upheld the ban on straight party voting that option will not be available for November election
- In addition to candidates there are 4 proposals. Legalizing Recreational Marijuana, Election Law Updating, County Park Millage Renewal, and a Citizen Commission to Establish Voting Districts.
