

ORDINANCE NO. 17-A

LIMA TOWNSHIP ELECTRICAL INSPECTION ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THE TOWNSHIP OF LIMA AS THE ENFORCING AGENCY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT, ACT NO. 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED; TO REPEAL ALL INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

THE TOWNSHIP OF LIMA, WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN
ORDAINS:

SECTION I. AGENCY DESIGNATED. Pursuant to the provision of the Michigan Electrical Code, in accordance with Section 9 of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Electrical Official of the Township of Lima is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Township of Lima under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Township of Lima assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.

SECTION II. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing the same.

This Ordinance was duly adopted by the Township of Lima at its regular meeting called and held on the First day of May, 2000, and was ordered given publication in the manner required by law.
