 know until mid-July. WWRA will make up any funds the Grant does provide to go ahead with the purchase of the new
 truck.
- Because of an "offer too good to refuse" a Seeing Eye mechanism for sorting will assist with Cassidy lake labor contract.
- The position for the new Educational Outreach Coordinator was filled.

Washtenaw Area Value Express (WAVE): Arlene Bareis

- Webster Township new Board representative is Barbara Calleja, Webster Township Clerk.
- \$5,500 education grant from Rural Education Systems
- Signed agreement with R.O.M.E. W.A.V.E. will pay \$13,000, Senior Center will pay \$50,000 for new bus.
